

## 8.00 Special Education Administration – Grades K – 12

### LEVEL 1: PROFESSIONAL REQUIREMENTS

A Special Education Administrator certificate, valid for a period of four (4) years from the date of issuance, will issued to applicants meeting the following requirements:

- A. **Possess a Missouri permanent or professional certificate of license to teach in an area of special education or student services:**
  - a. **Achieve a score equal to or greater than the Missouri qualifying score on the assessment designated by the State Board of Education;**
- B. **A minimum of two (2) years teaching experience in special education or student services approved by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education;**
- C. **Successful completion of the building –level administrator’s assessment designated by the State Board of Education;**
- D. **Completion of a course in Psychology and/or Education of the Exceptional Child (including the Gifted);**
- F. **Completion of a master’s degree in educational leadership [administration], from a college meeting approval of the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education to prepare school administrators; and**
- F. **Recommendation for certification for the designated official of a college/university approved by the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.**
