



Items to Submit for the EdD Application (Deadline: 1 April 2017)

1. Complete an application to the Graduate School. While on the UMSL home page, look for Admissions and below that click on Graduate. Within the application indicate you are applying for the EdD in Educational Practice and specify the STEM Education Enhancement Learning Community.
2. Complete the EdD Supplemental Application to the Learning Community. You can complete this form on your computer and allow the form to expand as needed. You can e-mail your Supplemental Application to coedocprograms@umsl.edu or mail it to the address below.
3. Ask three individuals who can speak to your professional practice to write a letter of recommendation addressing: your ability to communicate effectively (orally and in writing) and your ability to think critically. Recommendation letters can be emailed to coedocprograms@umsl.edu or mailed to the address below.
4. Send all transcripts of higher education work to the Graduate Admissions Office, as directed on the application to Graduate School.
5. Send a resume' or curriculum vita (C.V.) to coedocprograms@umsl.edu or mail it to the address below. Be sure to describe your professional practice.
