Writing Exit Requirements

All Ed.S. candidates must complete a scholarly paper. Students must establish a scholarly paper committee (M2 Form) consisting of three graduate faculty members. In consultation with the committee, the student will chose a topic for the paper. At least two (2) months before the completion of all course work for the degree, each student must present to their paper to the scholarly paper committee. The paper submitted may be original in that it has been written especially for this requirement or it may be a more comprehensive version of a paper written for a class taken after being admitted to the Ed.S. program.

Field Experience Requirements

All individuals seeking state certification must complete 300 clock hours in the appropriate field experience.
