

## **M.ED. ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES**

### **APPLICATION DEADLINE**

There is one application window for the M.Ed. in Education Administration. All materials must be submitted by March 1 for consideration for the fall semester.

### **PREREQUISITES**

**TEACHING EXPERIENCE:** Minimum of 3 years' successful PK-12 teaching experience in a school system. This may include experience from another state, and private, public, parochial, independent or charter schools.

**GRADE POINT AVERAGE:** The minimum GPA for regular admission is 2.75 in each of the three GPAs. Students with GPAs below 2.75 but above 2.50 are eligible to be admitted on restricted status. In this case, newly admitted graduate students must earn a 3.00 GPA in their first 12 credits of course work to continue study.
