✓ **DESE Substitute Certification**

- Create an ID with DESE at www.dese.mo.gov.
- Mail Official Transcripts to DESE, 205 Jefferson Street, PO Box 480, Jefferson City, MO 65102. Write "SUB CERT" on a sticky note to put on the envelope.
- Create a Profile by going to <https://k12apps.dese.moe.gov/WebLogin/login.aspx>. Then under Office of Educator Quality select Educator Certification System. Create a profile including your personal contact information. Then Select Substitute Certificate and complete the remaining fields, then choose Content Substitute. Submit all information to DESE.
